

# Pagers - text(file) viewers

*v1.0 (en), xiando*

All Linux distributions comes with quite a few text viewers (pagers).

The common ones are `cat`, `more`, `tail` and `less`.

The output from programs can be piped through any of these. They can also be used to view the contents of textfiles.

Examples:

```
more minfil.txt
```

```
dmesg | less
```
