3 critical and 4 moderate security-related bugs are fixed in version 1.0.3. Both Linux and Windows users are affected and are encouraged to upgrade as soon as possible.

Firefox is growing in popularity and black-hats desire to target the browser is increasing. Nine [security problems](#) are fixed in version 1.0.3, three of them are rather bad. You really should [upgrade Firefox](#) if you use this browser regularly. Some of the issues also apply to the [Mozilla browser](#), both Mozilla and Firefox are based on the Gecko rendering engine and share a large portion of the code base.
