This is the seventh development snapshot for the 0.1.2.x series. It makes rate limiting much more comfortable for servers, along with a huge pile of other bugfixes.

Tor allows you to browse the Internet without being subject to Traffic analysis.

It is an essential security tool for corporations, governments and private citizens.

The new alpha has major bugfixes for Windows users, better rate limiting for those who choose to help the Tor-network by running a server, fixes memory leaks and overall has many improvements under the hood.

It is worth upgrading if you are using an alpha version, and it is also worth trying if you are using the latest stable version.
